

*These figures do not reflect Operation Desert Storm nor estimates of as high as 3 Million civilian casualities who died as a result of U.S. "sanctions" and the destruction of the Iraqi social infrastructure from Desert Storm to the present.

<u>U.S. CASUALTIES</u>: Military or Civilian Personnel, injured or deceased as direct result of service in support of U.S. government "War on Terrorism." (Not to be confused with wounded, disabled or medically evacuated "casualties.")

Total Afghanistan Military Casualities-To 05/03: 8000 K.I.A. Total Afghanistan Military Seriously Wounded: 24,000 Total Iraqi Military Casualties: 30,000 K.I.A. Total Iraqi Military Seriously Wounded: 54,000 (May not reflect those who survive combat incident yet die seconds to months after medivac who are rumored to be reported as non-combat related casualities in an effort to keep reported K.I.A. 's minimal.)

U.S. Medical Casualties * to 07/14/04

Total Medical Evacuations (NON-HOSTILE): 7,000 - 10,000 Total Medical Evacuations (HOSTILE): 5,140 W.I.A.

*These figures <u>DO NOT</u> include those who have been treated in - theater, nor illness and injury such as Gulf War Syndrome, PTSD, or numerous aliments believed to be related to radiation and /or chemical/biological exposure. All military and civilan personnel deployed in current or recent theaters of engagement risk long term illness through exposure to these agents. The degree and severity of latter illness' appears at this time to be proportionally related to the periods of exposure.

I.E.D.: Improvised Explosive Device...i.e. "Land Mine" or "Booby Trap"

R.P.G.: Rocket Propelled Grenade

K.I.A.: Killed In Action

M.I.A. : Missing in Action

W.I.A.: Wounded in Action

O.E.F.: Operation Enduring Freedom (Afghanistan)

O.I.F.: Operation Iraqi Freedom

Enemy Ordi nance (re: helicopter casualties): Small Arms or Shoulder fired anti-aircraft missles

DU.ST.W.UN.: Duty Status Whereabouts Unknown = M.I.A.: Missing In Action

W.R.A.M.C : Walter Reed Army Medical Center

* preceeding name: indicates death occured on date listed but not "offically" relased until chronological location.

SPIN (SPUN) v. trans: To provide an interpretation of (a statement or event, for example), especially in a way meant to sway public opinion: In literature: détournement: inserting existing text, signs or images into new contexts to disrupt or reverse their established meanings; "semiotic guerrilla warfare," Umberto Eco.

<u>COLLATERAL DAMAGE:</u> Destruction or disabiling of non-military targets. Buildings, private property, hospitals, sewer and water treatment facilities, power systems etc. including non-combatant <u>CIVILIAN</u> Men, Women and Children. (alternately "spun" as: "The Cost of War" or "The Price of Freedom")
