

(non-combatant HUMAN\*) 02/02/04

AFGHANISTAN: Civilians KILLED: Low 3,291 High 3,831 AFGHANISTAN: Civilians Seriously Wounded: 5531 IRAQ: Civilians KILLED: Minimum 8245 Maximum 10,089 IRAQ: Civilians Seriously Wounded: 14,342

\*These figures do not reflect Operation Desert Storm nor estimates as high as 3 Million civilian casualities who died as a result of U.S. "sanctions" and the destruction of the Iraqi social infrastructure from Desert Storm to the present.

<u>U.S. CASUALTIES</u>: Military or Civilian Personnel, injured or deceased as direct result of service in support of U.S. government "War on Terrorism." (Not to be confused with wounded, disabled or medically evacuated "casualties.")

\*These figures <u>DO NOT</u> include those who have been treated in - theater, nor illness and injury such as Gulf War Syndrome, PTSD, or numerous aliments believed to be related to radiation and /or chemical/biological exposure. All military and civilan personnel deployed in current or recent theaters of engagement risk long term illness through exposure to these agents. The degree and severity of latter illness' appears at this time to be proportionally related to the periods of exposure.

**Enemy Ordnance** (re: helicopter casualties): Small Arms or Shoulder fired anti-aircraft missles **DU.ST.W.UN.**: Duty Status Whereabouts Unknown = **M.I.A.**: Missing In Action

\* preceeding name: indicates death occured on date listed but not "offically" relased until chronological location.

reverse their established meanings; "semiotic guerrilla warfare," **Umberto Eco. COLLATERAL DAMAGE:** Destruction or disabiling of non-military targets. Buildings, private property, hospitals, sewer and water treatment facilities, power systems etc. including non-combatant **CIVILIAN** Men, Women and Children. ( alternately "spun" as: "The Cost of War" or "The Price of Freedom")


